rich boysenberry and black cherry notes, hints of white pepper and violet

### Ventoux | 49 Chateau Bonpas, FRANCE '20

medium tannins, gravelly, red berries and pepper

### Montepulciano D'Abruzzo | 54 Torre Zambra, ITALY '20

food friendly, moderate alcohol, red cherries, smooth mouthfeel

### Red Blend | 58 Van Ardi, ARMENIA, '21

bright, lively, focused, raspberry/pomegranate, medium body

### Rioja Reserva | 94 La Rioja Alta S.A. "Vina Ardanza" SPAIN '16

tempranillo and garnacha, 36mo in american oak, dripping with opulent vanilla, sweet cherry, & toasted coconut

### Cabernet Sauvignon | 138 Honig, CALIFORNIA '19

a cool spring & mild summer created an expressive & fully developed wine 18 months in oak complete an interlacing of black raspberry flavors, plum, black pepper, and a hint of dry herbs.
