AZELIA "SAN ROCCO" BAROLO, 2019

125

Ripe cherry, sweet violet, balsamic and rhubarb with balanced minerality. Savoury on the palate, it shows velvety tannins of significant extraction with long-lasting acidity and great austere elegance.

CHEATEAU GRAND MAYNE GRAND CRU CLASSE, 2019

125

Floral, earthy, smoky, and racy, the wine exudes class and charm with its layers of medium-bodied silky, fresh and mineralistic red berries. Vibrant and refined with length and complexity,

SAN FELICE, "IL GRIGIO" CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA DOCG, 1.5L, 2016

140

Deep ruby red. Rich, long-lingering aromas are redolent of violets and wild red berries. Full-bodied yet lean and firm, with succulent tannins and a tangy acidity.

LAURENT-PERRIER, "LA CUVEE" CHAMPAGNE, 1.5L, NV

Fine and persistent bubbles, a delicate nose with hints of fresh citrus and white flowers. A perfect balance between freshness and delicacy with fruity flavours very present on the finish.

CASANUOVA DELLE CERBAIE, BRUNELLO 1.5L, 2008

165

Medium garnet with tawny edges from age, this wine is dry and tannic, with brandied cherry and orange zest on the nose. Complex and evolving on the palate. Tart cherry up front and leather, tobacco and spice on the finish. Medium bodied with good acid to balance out the tannins.

LIVINGSTON, CABERNET SAUVIGNON "GEMSTONE VINEYARD", 1999

185

Big and bold, but dry on the palate with plenty of sage and oregano. Refreshing acidity with tertiary mushroom and balanced, mellow tannins. Cherry and ripe red fruit on the nose, with a hint of white pepper that carries through the finish. Best enjoyed after 20 minutes of decanting.

LA RIOJA ALTA, S.A GRAN RESERVA 904 "SELECCIÓN ESPECIAL", 2015

185

Great aromatic complexity, with notes of wild strawberry, red cherry, plum, blackberry and cranberry combined with aromas of tobacco, brioche, ground coffee, caramel, cedar and cinnamon blossom. The alcohol and acidity are elegantly balanced on the palate and its polished, gentle tannins and freshness provide a smooth and refined mouthfeel.
